 - b. Learn about leadership, service, and scholarship opportunities for the school year and summer
 - c. Network with delegates and student leaders from around HCPSS
 - d. Provide feedback on HCPSS Policies
- 3. Compile questions that you feel are important to you and your school community.
 - a. YOU are a representative! This means that you are also speaking for your peers and community and the different issues and concerns that they find important.
 - b. Solicit input and feedback from as many students in your school community as you can.

4. On the day of Convention, you can expect to

- a. Ride a bus to Wilde Lake High School after you arrive at your home school for the day.
- b. Wear school spirit wear and/ or business attire
- c. Meet the students applying to run for Student Member of the Board of Education.
